Shield Your joyous ones, and all for Your love's sake. Amen.

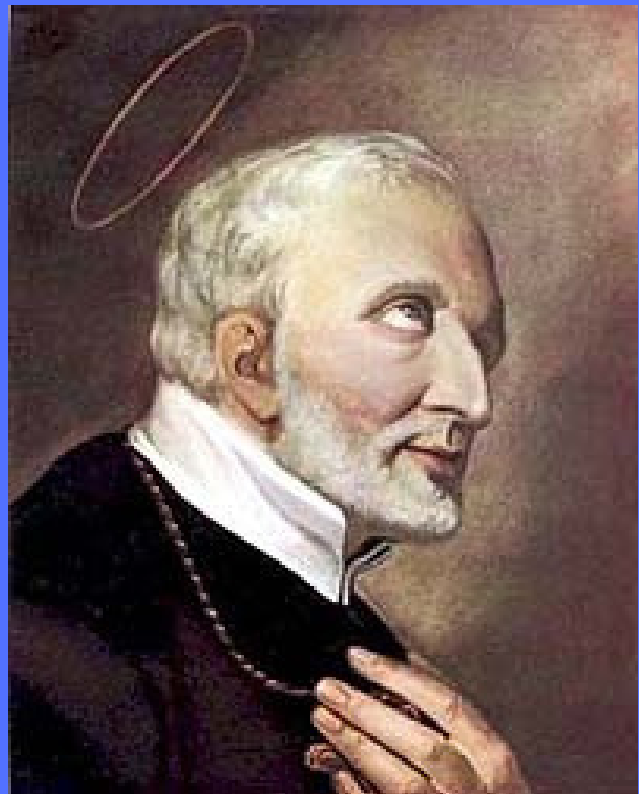
## Evening Prayer by St. Alphonsus Liguori

*St. Alphonsus (1696-1787) founded the Redemptorist order of priests and was a great teacher of moral theology. He was the bishop of Saint Agatha, Italy, and zealously reformed his diocese. A prolific writer, he penned about sixty books. He made a vow never to waste time and worked tirelessly for the good of the Church. He died in his 91st year.*
