Papal motto: "To renew all things in Christ"

**To his credit: Extended age of First Communion to age seven.
Advocated frequent Communion, continual Catechesis for all,**

daily Scripture reading by all.
Reformed the liturgy, promoted clear and simple homilies,
brought Gregorian chant back, condemned the Modernist heresy.
