

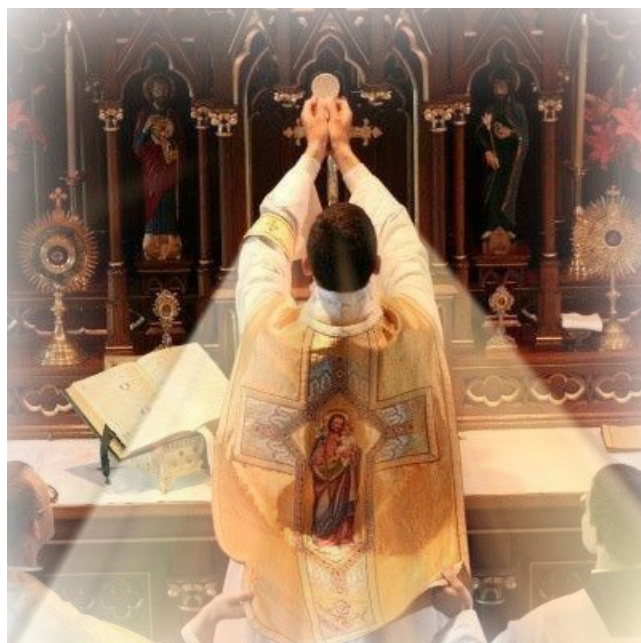

how can I return Your love?**

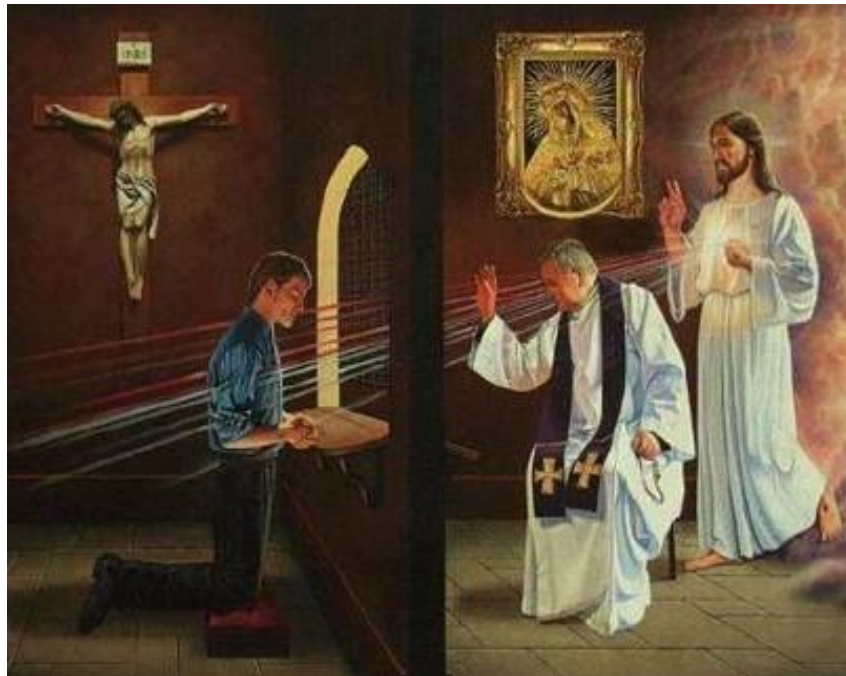
Wash me clean, dear Jesus, clean of every sin and weakness.
