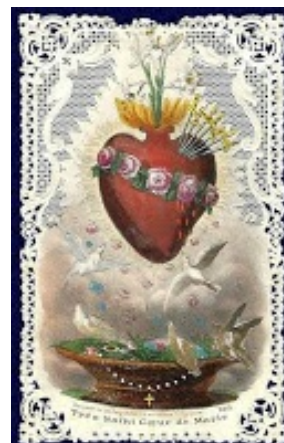

Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows

September 15

- * at the prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2:35);
- * at the flight into Egypt (Matt 2:13);
- * having lost the Holy Child at Jerusalem (Luke 2:48);
- * meeting Jesus on His way to Calvary;
- * standing at the foot of the Cross (John 19:25);
- * Jesus being taken from the Cross;
- * at the burial of Christ.
